President’s Message:

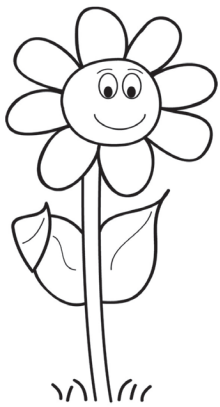

LX Club Phone:

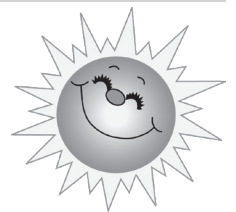

Baked Reuben Dip

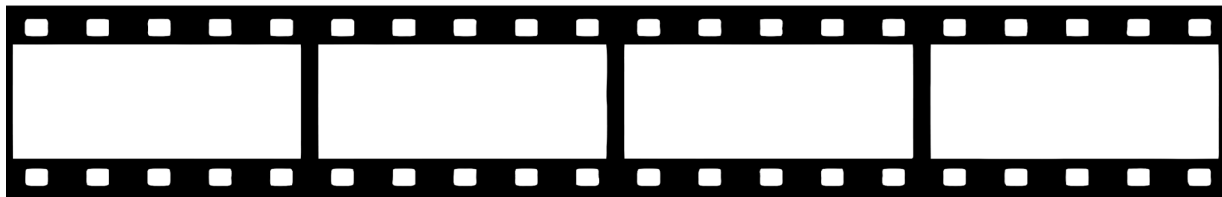
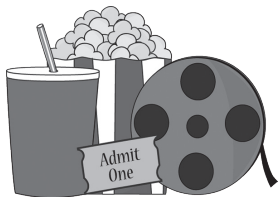
WHAT YOU NEED:

- 1 (8- ounce) package cream cheese, softened
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 1 (8- ounce) can sauerkraut, drained & chopped
- 1/2 pound deli sliced corned beef, finely chopped
- 1 cup (4- ounces) shredded Swiss cheese
- 1 tablespoon finely chopped onion
- 1 tablespoon ketchup
- 1 tablespoon spicy brown mustard

WHAT TO DO:

Preheat oven to 375* degrees F. Coat a 2-quart casserole dish with cooking spray In a large bowl, combine all ingredients, mix well, and spoon into casserole dish Bake 25 to 30 minutes, or until bubbly and golden, Serve warm.

Servie with crackers or cocktail rye bread.

One damp winter day he gets a call summoning him to his hometown, north of the city. His brother’s heart has given out suddenly and he’s been named guardian of his 16 year old nephew. As if losing his only sibling and doubts about raising a teenager weren’t enough, his return to the past re-opens an unspeakable tragedy. 2 hours 17 minutes.

May 10, 2017 “Fences”

Academy Award nominated movie. An African American father struggles with race relations in the United States while trying to raise his family in the 1950’s and coming to terms with events in his life. 2 hours 19 minutes.

May 24, 2017 “Jackie”

Academy Award nominated movie follows the aftermath of the assassination of Jackie Kennedy’s husband, and her fight through grief and trauma. She must confront the unimaginable consoling of her two young children, vacating the home she painstakingly restored and planning her husband’s funeral. 1 hour 40 minutes.

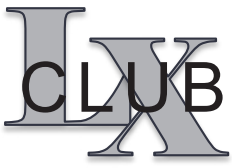
